Bellavista Brut, Franciacorta, Italy, nv

(90 Wine Advocate) 13.00

Delicious methode Champenoise from Italy's sparkling wine standard bearer

WHITE WINES

Arcadian Chardonnay "Dierberg Vineyard", Santa Maria, 2006

(91 Tanzer) 9.50

From the noted Dierberg Vineyard in Santa Maria, comes a fantastic Chard made by the passionate Joe Davis. The nose offers up vanilla bean, lime, Meyer lemon custard with a hint of cream, the body is full and rich with well integrated oak and perfectly judged acidity. Joe makes wines meant to pair with food, not over blown, heavy, butterballs.

Pieropan Soave Classico, Veneto, Italy, 2008

9.00

Pinot Grigio fans should try this delicious Soave from Veneto region. Long one of the region's qualitative leaders, Pieropan blends Garganega (85%) and Trebbiano (15%) and ages them for only a few months in large oak foudres. The medium-bodied wine has apple and stone fruit flavors with hints of chamomile, minerals and almond. It finishes dry and refreshing

Johann Haart Riesling Piesporter Goldtropfchen, Mosel, 2007

8.50

This lovely, light bodied off dry Riesling has crisp green apple fruit, excellent minerality, hints of slate and juicy acidity.

RED WINES

Catena Cabernet Sauvignon, Mendoza, Argentina, 2006

(90/100 Wine Advocate) 10.00

This high altitude (the vineyards are at the feet of the Andes) 100% Cabernet is dark in color with aromas and flavors of black currant, blackberry, cedar, hints of herbs, espresso & graphite. It is ripe, rich, layered & lush in texture.

Valle Reale Montepulciano D'Abruzzo, Italy 2006

(3 Glass Award - Gambero Rosso) 10.50

We been fans of this winery for several years now but this 2006 sets a new standard for quality and represents one of the greatest values that we can recall. Winner of the prestigious 3 Glass award from the noted Italian wine journal, Gambero Rosso, this 100% Montepulciano from old vines really delivers the goods. It is dark in color, with expressive aromatics of black and red cherry and plum and notes of earth and tobacco. On the palate, it is rich and lush with the same dark fruit flavors wedded to leather, tobacco and chocolate notes. It finishes with smooth tannins and well integrated acidity. PS- the varietal, Montepulciano is no relation to the Tuscan region of the same name nor to be confused with Montalcino.

Arcadian Syrah "Sleepy Hollow Vineyard", Santa Lucia Highlands, 2005

(91 Tanzer) 12.00

This full-bodied Syrah has a nose redolent of ripe, dark berries, spices, pepper & violet. On the palate, it expresses red and dark berry fruit as well as savory, meaty notes, black olives and hints of minerals. Tannins are ripe and chewy and juicy acidity provides vibrancy. Joe Davis is at the top of his game, and this richly fruited, structured Syrah from the much admired Sleepy Hollow vineyard in the excellent 2005 vintage is a real winner.

Zenato Valpolicella Superiore, Veneto, Italy, 2007

9.00

This fine Valpolicella (a blend of Corvina Veronese, Molinara & Rondinella) has ripe red & black cherry fruit & floral notes, on the palate, it is all about creamy cherry fruit (dipped in chocolate) and a seamless and fleshy texture.

745	Les Cretes Chardonnay “Les Frissonaire”, Val d’ Aosta, Italy, 2007 (“Tre Bicchieri” Gambero Rosso & 90 Wine Spectator)	59.00
	<i>From the northwestern region of Val d’ Aosta famous for the Mont Blanc tunnel to France and its fine Fontina Val d’ Aosta cheese, this medium to full-bodied Chardonnay is 100% free of any oak contact. Such treatment preserves its pristine fruit which is dominated by the aromas and flavors of perfumed white peach, followed by apple and mineral nuances. It has lovely purity and balance as well as subtle length.</i>	
892	Araujo Sauvignon Blanc “Eisele Vineyard”, Napa, 2007 (92 Tanzer)	68.00
	<i>Year in year, this is one of California’s elite Sauvignon Blancs. It is pricey (after all it comes from one of the most hallowed Cabernet vineyards in all of California) but well worth it. It’s expressive nose ranges from melon, lemon drop, anise, wax and honeysuckle. On the medium bodied palate, expect citrus-driven flavors with floral and mineral notes, excellent flavor intensity and substantial length. It is partly aged in small French barrels with a majority of it done in stainless steel, so you get richness without getting too much oak and losing the varietal vivacity.</i>	
327	Pegasus Bay Riesling, Waipara Bay, New Zealand, 2006 (93 Wine Advocate)	49.00
	<i>These guys have been on a roll with Pinot Noir, Sauvignon & Riesling. Off-dry and beautifully balanced, this delicious Riesling has a lovely interplay of white fruits, honeysuckle & spices with its stony mineral elements. It is medium in body with just a hint of sweetness and excellent length.</i>	
560	Patz & Hall Chardonnay “Hyde Vineyard”, Carneros, 2005 (93 Tanzer)	65.00
	<i>Annes Moses & James Hall seem to go from strength to strength with each successive vintage. This is a superb example of their handy work. The nose is quite nuanced with notes of lemon, custard, mineral, spice & smoke. On the palate, its richness and fruit are balanced beautifully by the nervy acidity, mineral flavors and sense of terroir rare in California Chardonnay. Superb stuff!</i>	
040	Muller-Catoir “Haardter Burgergarten”, Spatlese, Mosel, 2005 (93 Wine Spectator)	72.00
	<i>This is spectacularly good German Riesling from a truly elite producer. It is rich and lush but not at all too sweet. Loaded with fruit that ranges from Meyer lemon, orange blossom & yellow plum, it manages to combine a sense of honeyed creaminess with a stony minerality.</i>	
065	Tramin “Stoan”, Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy 2007 (92 Wine Advocate)	65.00
	<i>An innovative blend of 60% Chardonnay and 11% Pinot Bianco fermented in oak with 22% Sauvignon and 7% Traminer fermented in stainless steel. The latter two provide aromatic display elderflower blossom, apple, honey and spice, which repeat on the palate with a hint of banana, brown spice & minerals. It is rich and would pair well with rich fish & poultry dishes. This is certainly one of Italy’s finest and most distinctive white wines.</i>	
500	Txomin Etxaniz, Txakoli, Getaria, Spain, 2007 (91 Tanzer)	44.00
	<i>Offering a wine as difficult to pronounce to non-Euskara speakers (the Basque language) can be challenging but here goes. First pronouncing it would help: zjoe-min eh-jan-eez cha-koe-lee is our theory, but plain cha-kolee will suffice. Made from Hondarribi grape, this light bodied, eminently refreshing, slightly sparkling wine never has any contact with oak. It has a subtle floral note, lemon-lime citrus flavors, notes of talc sea salt and other minerals, and a subtle green apple note. The moderate sparkling of its bubbles adds to the unique and refreshing experience. This is probably for the more adventurous of diners.</i>	
155	Alban Viognier “Alban Estate Vineyard”, Edna Valley, 2007 (92 Tanzer / 93 Wine Advocate)	70.00
	<i>Its nose expresses ripe peach, apricot, smoke, nuts & honeysuckle. On the rich & layered palate, flavors of peach & peach pit-almond echo and linger on the long, mineral finish.</i>	
958	Gini Soave “Salvarenza Vigna Vecchie”, Veneto, 2006 (92 Wine Advocate, 90 Spectator)	62.00
	<i>One of Italy’s finest white wines, this single vineyard Soave (90% Garganega & 10% Terrbiano d’ Soave) is made from 80 year old vines and is aged in its lees in French oak for 9 months. Only made in excellent vintages, it is rich and creamy with aromas and flavors of orange blossom, peach & citrus with complicating notes of almond, wax & minerals.</i>

081	Conterno Fantino Barbera d' Alba, "Vignota", Piemonte, Italy, 2006 <i>This opulent yet very intense Barbera is loaded with ripe dark fruit (blackberry & black cherry), notes of bitter chocolate, espresso & minerals, rich texture, chewy but ripe tannin, & excellently integrated acidity. This is what modern Barbera is all about (Merlot drinkers take note!)</i>	(92 Tanzer) 59.00
573	Havens "Bourriquot", Napa, 2002 <i>We have been long-time fans of this St. Emilion-style blend of nearly equal parts Cabernet Franc and Merlot. Bourriquot (loosely translated as "stubborn work horse" as a humble nod to the great Chateau Cheval Blanc) is about finesse, elegance and aromatic, not about size and extraction. That being said, there is no lack of either fruit (blue & black) or flesh here, what really stands out, though is inner mouth perfume and nuances of menthol, minerals, tobacco and chocolate. This does not hit you over the head, but beguiles you by revealing its subtleties.</i>	(91 Tanzer) 59.00
285	Ridge "Lytton Springs", Dry Creek, Sonoma, 2006 <i>Some flashy names and extremely ripe wines often catch more attention and hype, but Ridge remains one of our favorite Zinfandel producers (not to mention making one of the five or six consistently finest Cabernet based blends in California, the great Montebello). Winemaker, "Eminence Gris" Paul Draper, has been running the show for 40 years now, preaching and practicing a "gospel" of making balanced, elegant, age-worthy Zins. The current vintage of the single vineyard Lytton Springs is certainly representative of his credo. The final blend is 80% Zinfandel, 16% Petite Sirah (for structure) and 4% Carignane. On the nose, expect aromas of brambly berry fruits and hints of floral & mineral notes as well as notes of licorice & a hint of floral notes. The texture is polished and sappy without any sense of over-ripeness. Classy stuff.</i>	(92 Tanzer) 62.00
335	Arietta "H Block Hudson Vineyard", Napa Valley, 2001 <i>Now we understand that some "brands" continue to have a mystique that far outlives the actual greatness of the wine (or whatever else it may be). But I remain puzzled by how some others never seem to register with people in spite of superb quality. Crafted by the great John Kongsgaard, this blend of 60% Cabernet Franc and 40% Merlot is sourced from the superb Hudson Vineyard in the fine 2001 vintage. It has an explosive nose of cassis, dried flowers & espresso, to name a few scents expressed. On the palate it is silky, lush & rich but not at all heavy. Cassis, tobacco, spice & earth tones sing on the palate. If you are going to splurge in this tough economic time, this fantastic and underappreciated label deserves your attention! 546	Finca Sandoval Syrah, Manchuela, Spain, 2003 <i>This producer literally exploded on the scene in 2001 with instant critical acclaim, single-handedly reviving this appellation with Syrah cuttings from Beaucastel in the Rhone. Dark in color, the aromatics are classic Syrah: super-ripe black fruit, licorice, black pepper and chocolate. On the palate, there is luscious, sweet blackberry and cassis fruit, full-body that expresses the ripeness of the 2003 vintage, and chewy ripe tannins. 727	Fattoria Selvapiana Chianti Rufina Riserva "Bucerchiale", 2004 <i>Perennially one of our favorite Chiantis, the single vineyard Bucerchiale hits all the right notes in the excellent 2004 vintage. The pure, black cherry fruit is complicated by tobacco leaf, tanned leather & brown spices.
